

Mon. 5. 4. 26.

At the pleasure of a very hopeless case of a school boy ~~being~~ ^{having} successfully passed through a serious illness in the Hospital, Dr Karkhal gave a tea party to Baba and the Mandali. The function came off very successfully at 4 ~~4~~ o'clock this afternoon, when the Doctor was presented with a silver flower pot by Baba in recognition of his untiring efforts after the patient. Similarly Padri and Pendo the two chief hospital workers amongst the Mandali were also presented with woollen mufflers for their ardent devotion to the respective duties allotted to them which resulted into a life being saved. Later in the evening a game of Aha Patas was played by the Mandali when Baba also participated in the game. Mr Subtarushi M. L. C. M. A. L. S. was one of the visitors today. Baba discussed some divine subjects for about three quarters of an hour till 10.45. tonight, after which all left him at his seat after paying the last respects for the day.

Tue. 6. 4. 26.

The Height Of Consideration!

Baba personally went in the village and brought those Inchar persons who were undergoing the penance fasting to Incharabad when at 9 P.M. they were given milk and Jawari^{bread} to eat under his own supervision.

Wed. 7. 4. 26.

The fasters were again treated with tea in the noon today. While in the evening the whole of the Incharwad was given a dinner of Dhal & Rice.

Tooth powder was begun to be given to all the boys and the Mandali members from this morning.

Thur. 8. 4. 26. In addition to the daily activities and the usual Thursday functions that were all gone through duly, the children were given a bath by Baba and the mandali. Dhan-Sak was prepared for dinner today which was also taken by Baba. The boys were ^{given to the} given $1\frac{1}{2}$ quarters ^{per} of milk from this morning, while this evening every one of the Incherabad residents were also given milk and jawari bread for supper. The mandali getting 2 cups of milk each.

Fri. 9. 4. 26.

The ~~written~~ ^{signed} or thumb impressed writings that were taken from those of the Inchar parents and guardians who had ~~shown~~ shown concern at their boys being 'prepared for war' were turned up today in the presence of all the respective signatories by Baba. Keshav, one of the school boys, having safely passed through a deadly attack of high temperature and double pneumonia today, a liberal distribution of jalebis was made throughout the colony.

Sat. 10. 4. 26.

Baba and a few of the mandali had been to Kaka's place this afternoon for dinner when ~~they~~ the party enjoyed a good assortment of selected hindoo dishes. In the afternoon the boys were bathed, after which they were entertained to a show of sleight of hand tricks which was cleverly executed by a party of professional jugglers that ~~was~~ happened to pass through the colony. They were paid five rupees for the show.

Sun. 11. 4. 26. There is nothing particular to note today than a 'Papad' party that was enjoyed by Baba and mandali in the village and the Bhajans that followed in the local Mandir in their presence.

Mon 12. 4. 26. The water was found to be getting very less and less in the Incherabad well, so from today it was closed for all purposes save that of drinking, and water required for washing and bathing was begun to be brought from outside through special water carts procured for that purpose.

Tue. 13. 4. 26. Baba personally participated in the games of Atta Patas and cricket this afternoon and again in the evening respectively.

Wed. 14. 4. 26. Rangzan Id! On account of the above holiday, today, the schools were closed, ~~too~~ and a special tea party was given to all. The mandali and the boys were also given Jelebis. Barsoip, Kurin, and two of the musliman boys in the school were presented by Baba with new clothes while the former two were also supplied with a glass of syrup each.

An old christian hag ~~nearly~~ ^{that} nearly 100 years old, was admitted in the hospital a few days ago died this evening. She was duly buried in the village cemetery under Baba's personal supervision.

When Baba and party returned at 9.30. in the night after the burial, Shri delivered with signs and writing a fine lecture upon the

the mysteries of Death for about ~~an~~ half an hour while standing near the 'Inakau', after which, all took to their respective beddings.

Thur. 15. 4. '26

At the usual tea party at Kaka's place this afternoon Baba discoursed for about two hours upon divine subjects to the great delight of the mandali. After that the boys were bathed.

The recent increase of milk to all the boys necessitates a large quantity of that produce to be procured, so much so that nearly 18 seers in the morning and 23 seers of milk in the evening is received daily for this purpose. The boys were again entertained to a magic show tonight at night in the Sai-Durbar which was greatly appreciated by the kiddies.

Sun. 18. 4. '26

Baba, mandali, and the boys were all invited to tea at Marwati Patel's house in the village at 4 o'clock in the afternoon when Bhajyas and various other eatables were freely served to all.

Following the tea party Baba took all the boys for a walk to the hill when again after returning from the walk all were given milk tea at Inherabad. A large number of Sikh soldiers were amongst the daily visitors to Baba.

Tue 20. 4. '26
